**GENERAL SITUATION:**

- **Apayao Province:**
  - PDRRMC closely monitoring the water level of Apayao river.
  - Rubber boats were already prepositioned.
  - Equipment for SAR operation was prepositioned.
  - Evacuation areas are already prepared for possible implementation of pre-emptive evacuation.
  - Due to effects of strong winds, damages to agriculture sector are expected.
  - Power was already restored by CAGELCO in some areas.
  - The Provincial DRRMC and lower DRRMC are on heightened alert.
- **Kalinga Province:**
  - **Partial report of damaged houses:** Fifty nine (59) houses were partially damaged and five (5) houses totally damaged at the Municipality of Lubuagan.
  - Two (2) national roads are still closed to traffic.
  - Power is not yet restored in the municipalities of Lubuagan and Balbalan.
  - The Provincial DRRMC and lower DRRMC are on heightened alert.
- **Mt Province:**
  - The Provincial DRRMC is on heightened alert. Local response teams on standby.
  - The municipality of Bontoc is experiencing power interruption since 2:30 PM.
  - Two (2) national roads are closed to traffic.
- **Benguet Province:**
  - Gov Fongwan declared the suspension of classes in all levels today
  - Small scale mining operations was suspended since yesterday due to inclement weather.
  - 1 road is closed to traffic due to series of landslides along the road.
  - The Provincial DRRMC and local DRRMC are on heightened alert.
- **Baguio City:**
  - Mayor Mauricio Domogan declared the suspension of classes on all levels.
  - The Baguio City DRRMC and local DRRMCs are on heightened alert.
  - Local response teams responded to incidents of 8 fallen trees, 2 flash flooding and 1 minor landslide incident.
  - Power was already restored by BENECO in some areas.
- **Ifugao Province:**
  - As of 1:00 PM today, province wide power was restored by IFELCO;
  - Flowering crops are now affected by the winds felt as reported by the Ifugao PDRRMC;

- Two (2) houses were reported partially damaged at Tinoc Ifugao.
- The Ifugao PDRRMC is now on Red ALERT.

- **Abra Province:**

- **Partial report of damages to houses:** One (1) totally damaged and one (1) partially damaged house due to a fallen tree along Brgy. Calaba, Bangued Abra.
- Abra- Kalinga road km 4073+950 was closed due to fallen tree reported as of 6:00 PM

**Actions taken for preparedness:**

**OCD-CAR**

- OCD-CAR Operations Center is still on **RED ALERT STATUS** and continuously focused on monitoring, information dissemination, and giving warnings to the public in preparation for the possible effect of TY ODETTE in Cordillera;
- Continuous coordination with CRDRRMC members, LDRRMCs, and partners for weather conditions, impending threats, and information dissemination;
- Directly coordinated with provincial DRRM officers to address necessary precautionary measures and updates;
- Attended to media queries and interviews
- Addressed Media inquiries via telephone and cellphone communication;
- Continuously sending weather updates, bulletins and road condition advisories through the OCD-CAR INFO BOARD text blast,
- Advised concerned LGUs to implement PRE EMPTIVE EVACUATION.
- With ready QRF amounting to 6.8 Million Pesos.

**DPWH**

- Ongoing road clearing operations to roads that are still closed to traffic.
- Continuously monitoring road situations; and
- Prepositioned equipment: 13 Dump trucks, 6 Pay loader, 7 Road Grader, 1 Excavator, 1 Roller.

## **PRO - CORDILLERA**

- PNP focal person on duty at the OCD-CAR Operations Center
- Activated OPLAN SAKLOLO;
- Responded to areas with reported landslides
- Assisting the OCD-CAR in the dissemination of warning advisories and weather information;
- Alerted all Provincial Police Offices (PPO) for the possible impact of TS ODETTE in their AOR.
- With ready equipment for response: 1 Ambulance, 4 rubber boats, 3 troop carrier trucks; and
- Prepositioned 130 units of PNP Search and Rescue boxes (blue box) in high risk municipalities in the region.

- Activated the Operations center
- SWAD Team on Standby; and
- Continuous coordination with City Social Welfare
- With ready QRF amounting to Php500,000.00
- Prepositioned family packs in the provinces.
- Collated a total of (81) eighty one families affected by TY Odette of which three (3) from Baguio City, two (2) in Tinoc Ifugao, Seventy eight (78) in Lubuagan, Kalinga.
- Given a total of Php 1,025,000 monetized value of assistance.

- Informs the public on the precautionary and preparedness measures.
